Temperature Screening



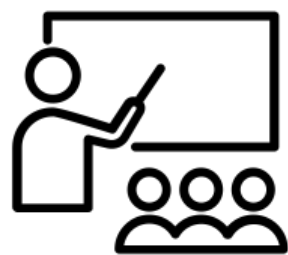
- ✓ Temperature screening will take place daily for all faculty and staff along with wellness questionnaire.
- ✓ Daily Wellness Check will be in place for all students.
 - **Families will be responsible for keeping children home if they are not feeling well.**
 - **Temperature will be checked for all students when they arrive in the car line.**
 - **Students who are late will be checked at the front door; parents will be required to walk students to the door.**

Masks



- ✓ Faculty and Staff will be required to wear a face mask or face shield throughout the day.
- ✓ It is required that students have a mask with them each day. Students will be required to wear a mask in common areas or when social distancing is not possible. There will be times when students may not need to wear a mask. This may include classroom time, while eating, and outdoor activities.
- ✓ A face mask will be provided by the school if a student does not have one.

Training



- ✓ Professional development will be provided to all faculty and staff before school begins on symptoms and screening measures.
- ✓ The school will provide parents and students with a variety of resources before school starts to help understand new procedures and guidelines.
- ✓ Students will receive training within the classroom on proper social distancing and ways to prevent the spread of germs.

Visitors



- ✓ Parents/visitors needing to enter the building will enter through the front door and will be required to wear a mask.
- ✓ Parents/Visitors will NOT be allowed in classrooms or the cafeteria.
- ✓ Parents/Visitors will NOT be allowed to enter the building through the breezeway entrance.



Classroom/School Environment



- ✓ Social distancing will be encouraged throughout the school day.
- ✓ The amount of movement within the building will be limited.
- ✓ All student desks will face the same direction in the classroom.
- ✓ Seating charts will be mandatory in all classrooms, cafeteria, and Church.
- ✓ Water fountains will not be used; students will be allowed to bring water bottles to drink from throughout the day.
- ✓ Signage will be posted throughout school to promote social distancing.
- ✓ Changes will be made in classroom to create more personal space.
- ✓ Students will use their own supplies; sharing supplies will be kept to a minimum.
- ✓ Times will be scheduled throughout day for hand washing.
- ✓ Special Area teachers will go to the classrooms.

Cafeteria

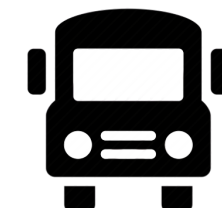
- ✓ Adjustments will be made to ensure social distancing for lunch.
- ✓ Self serve will be eliminated - Utensils and condiments will be provided on tray.
- ✓ All food service employees will be required to wear mask and gloves.
- ✓ Food sharing will be prohibited; make sure food does not need to be microwaved.

Recess



- ✓ Students will go to recess, weather permitting.
- ✓ The number of students for each recess period will be limited.

Field Trips



- ✓ There will be no field trips until further notice.

Enhanced Cleaning

- ✓ Sanitizing scheduled throughout the day for all high touch areas such as restrooms, door knobs, and handrails.
- ✓ The entire school will be cleaned nightly.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer will be available in all rooms.



Positive Covid-19 case reporting

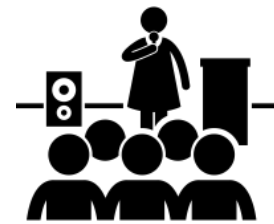
- ✓ St. Anthony School will work with the Clark County Health Department on notification, quarantine options, and possible school closure.
- ✓ Contact tracing will be conducted with the help of the Clark County Health Department to determine level of exposure and risk.

Other Illness



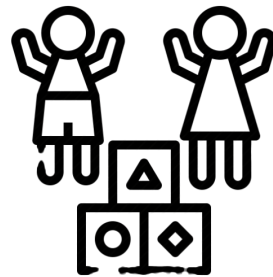
- ✓ Students **MUST** be fever free for 72 hours without the use of fever reducing medication before they can return to school or have a doctor's note stating the student can return to school.

Assemblies



- ✓ Assemblies and large gatherings will not take place if social distancing is not feasible.
- ✓ This could include activities such as: Pep Sessions, Grandparent's Day, Christmas Program, etc.

Preschool



- ✓ Preschool students will remain in the preschool building throughout the entire day.
- ✓ Preschool students will not be allowed to use our Before School or After School care program.
- ✓ All guidelines from this plan will be put into place at the preschool building.

Before School Care

- ✓ Before School Care will only be provided for students in grades K-8.
- ✓ For social distancing purposes, we ask that families only send students to Before Care when necessary and essential.
- ✓ Students attending Before School Care will be required to sit with their sibling(s) and **MUST** wear a mask.
- ✓ Students will sign into Before Care.

After School Care

- ✓ After School Care will only be provided for students in grades K-8.
 - ✓ For social distancing purposes, we ask that families only send students to After Care when necessary and essential.
 - ✓ Students attending After School Care will be required to wear a mask while indoors when social distancing is not possible.
 - ✓ Students will have assigned seats in After School Care.
